George was appointed as Denver County Veteran Service Officer in January 2007. He also manages the Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program grant for the City and County and the Veterans Trust Fund.

Previously, George engaged in university research and taught for 30 years, at Otero Junior College and Western State College in Colorado. He conducted research and taught at Brown University and Indiana University. George also held teaching positions at St. Mary's College and Linfield College. He is a life-long member of the Bricklayers Masons and Plasters Union.

George is a Vietnam veteran and served six years in the US Navy as a signalman and rescue swimmer. His interest in working with veterans stems from a chance encounter with a friend from Vietnam service who was living homeless on the streets of Portland Oregon.

He received the 2007-08 Veteran Service Officer of the Year Award in Colorado.

George has a Ph.D. in Demography from Brown University and a master's degree from the University of Chicago. His research work focused on urbanization and economic development.
