Ian Lisman has worked with homeless veterans through the Homeless Veteran Reintegration Program, HVRP, for five years as an outreach specialist, case manager and program coordinator. Ian is a combat veteran from the Desert Storm conflict, and draws from his own experiences reintegrating back into civilian life to help fellow veterans overcome some of the same obstacles he faced.

In his current position, Ian has trained numerous employees, assists in writing, developing and executing Federal Grants. He has assisted homeless clients in obtaining housing, ID's, employment, medical, mental health, and a variety of other services. Ian also designs, implements and teaches several classes for employees and clients. He has served as a city and community liaison for many public events, including the annual veterans stand-down event, Veterans Day parade, project homeless connect, community re-entry program, and the diversity veterans event.

Ian plans to complete a B.S in Human Services with a concentration in counseling and mental health from Metropolitan State College in August 2009. He also obtained a certificate in case management and has taken several accredited classes through the National Veterans Training Institute (NVTI).
